*McMurdo Station, Antarctica ...* ECMC Services, Inc. has been awarded a contract to design a gasoline pipeline and fuel dispensing system at the McMurdo Station research facility in Antarctica. The project, awarded in conjunction with Swanson-Rink, Denver, is managed by Raytheon Polar Services Company, Denver, and is sponsored by the National Science Foundation (NSF). The facility supports a wide range of cold weather research for the US Government in Antarctica. The pipeline will support the ongoing operations at the station.

Fuel Storage for the Antarctic is critical because fuel can only be delivered during the summer months and only then with an ice-breaker ship leading the tanker into port. The cold weather work is similar to ECMC's other work in near-arctic conditions in Minnesota and Alaska. Company President Frank Prieto was excited about this opportunity and the chance to work on the seventh continent. He stated "The project is a nice fit with our other work locations and compliments ECMC's global resume that includes projects in Guam and Midway Atoll in the Pacific."
